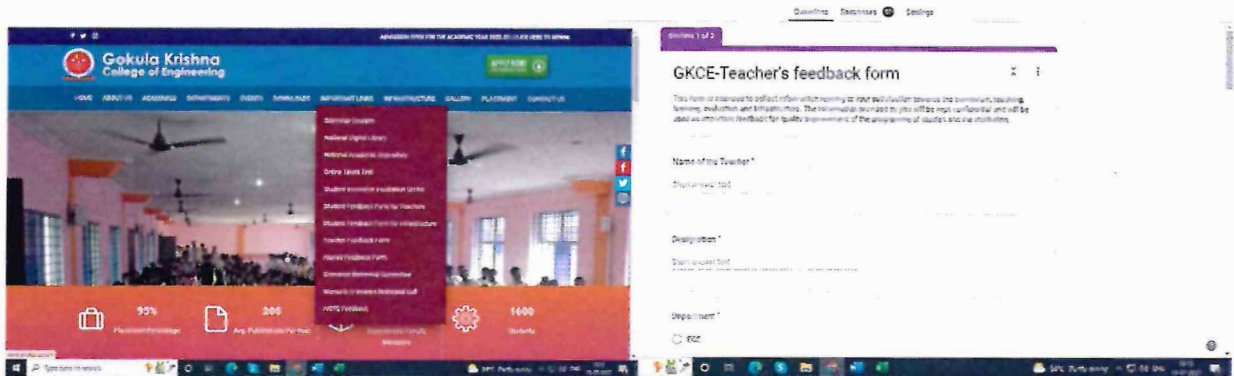

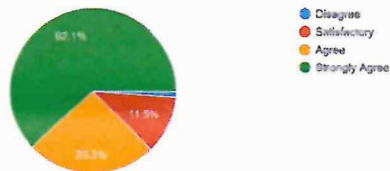

Screen shots of the feedback system in the college website

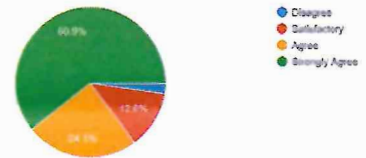


Graphical Analysis of Teachers' Feedback response

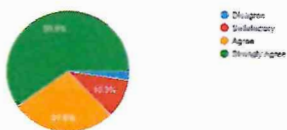
Infrastructural facilities are available in the college

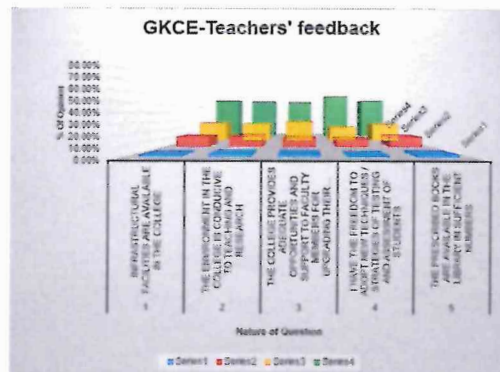

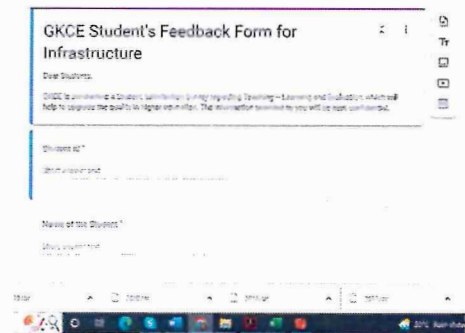

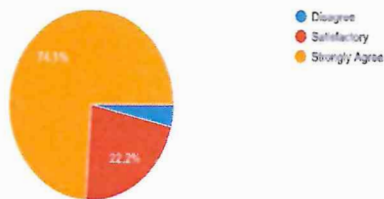

Graphical Analysis of Student's Feedback for Infrastructure

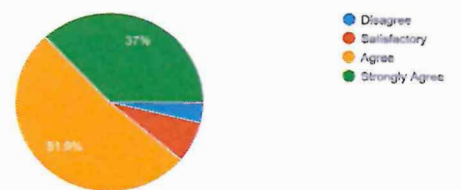
Availability of prescribed books/reading materials

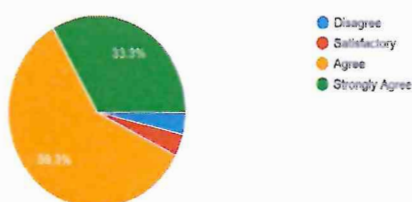

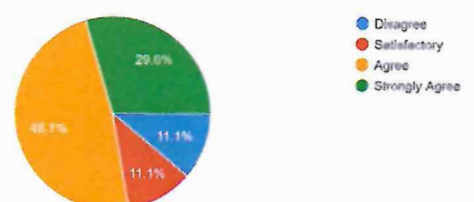

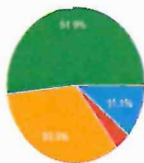

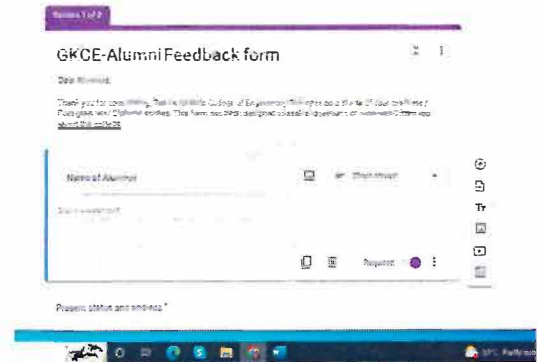

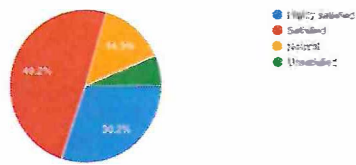

Screen shots of the feedback system in the college website

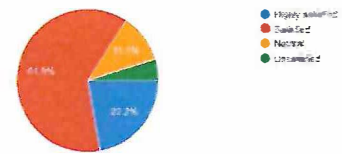


Graphical Analysis of Alumni Feedback response

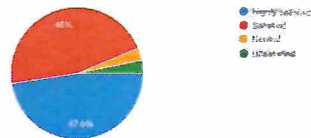

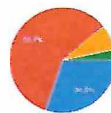
Involvement of teachers in college activities for teaching
